




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Places you need to visit in Vilnius you won't regret!

#### VU

Welcome to Vilnius University - the oldest and largest Lithuanian higher education institution.

Since its establishment in the 16th century, Vilnius University, as integral part of European science and culture has embodied the concept of a classical university and the unity of studies and research.





The history of the Palace dates back to the sole document written over 600 years ago - the edict by Grand Duke Jogaila of 17 February 1387. After Lithuania converted to Christianity in 1387, Grand Duke Jogalla founded the Vilnius Diocese, donating to it a land plot nearby "Goštauto Garden on the edge of the city of Vilnius".

#### Church of St. Anne

The first church at this site, constructed of wood, was built for Anna, Grand Duchess of Lithuania, the first wife of Vytautas the Great. Originally intended for the use of Catholic Germans and other visiting Catholics, it was destroyed by a fire in 1419



#### Monastery of The Bernardine Trail **Cultural Route**

This church is an awesome way to spend an evening by walking through the historic halls.

#### Cathedral square of Vilnius

The cathedral square was founded as late as 19th century, during the reconstruction and refurbishment of the cathedral. Previously, the area was densely populated and built up with medieval and renaissance houses. Parts of the area were also occupied by the Lower Castle



## VILNIUS



Gediminas Castle is the most frequently visited National Museum of Lithuania. Legend has it that the Grand Duke Gediminas dreamt of an Iron Wolf howling at the top of this hill. The hill is where he eventually built a wooden castle.

## VILNIUS CATHEDRA

Vilnius Cathedral is built in the very centre of the city. The shrine was rebuilt several times as a result of frequent fires and wars.

Gediminas Avenue is the city centre's main artery, starting at Cathedral Square and running all the way to the Lithuanian Parliament. It's a lively street with a lot going on.

#### THE GATE OF DAWN



The Gate of Dawn is a building in Vilnius, on Gate of Dawn Street, one of the most important historical, cultural and religious monuments in Vilnius, an object of secular and religious tourism, a historical and architectural monument.

#### CHURCH OF ST. THERESA

Vilnius St. Theresa's Church - a church located in the southern part of the Old Town of Vilnius near the Dawn Gate.



#### CHURCH OF ST. CASIMIR

Vilnius St. Casimir Church is a church located in the Old Town of Vilnius. This is the first and oldest baroque church in Vilnius.

#### VILNIUS TOWN HALL


Vilnius Town Hall is a historical town hall in the square of the same name in the Old Town of Vilnius, Lithuania.






#### STIKLIU STREET
