Just imagine your ancestors for a second, cavemen for example, what did they do to entertain themselves?.. Yes! they took stones and bashed them together to make sound.




Paris 1849

So what do you say if we would try to make our own little instruments out of **recycled materials**. And make music out of them.





How to make the instrument

First you have to know what instrument you are making. It could be a guitar, or it could be a drum. But let's just imagine that's it's a guitar.


Step 1


Next you need to choose a **material** on a few materials that you are gonna use. So for example we used a **cardboard box** and a few **threads or bands**. What we do is cut out a **hole** in the middle of the box.



Step 2

Then we take a **cylinder** or a piece of cardboard and stick them together. Now we attach the **threads** so each side of **the guitar**. Now you have successfully made a **working music instrument!**
